

## **ORHS BOYS' SOCCER BOOSTER CLUB MEETING MINUTES – NOVEMBER 17, 2020**

- ❖ The meeting was called to order at 6:04pm
  
- ❖ **Secretary's Minutes**
  - The minutes from the October 27<sup>th</sup> meeting (previously posted on the ORHS Men's Soccer website) were reviewed and approved
  
- ❖ **Treasurer's Report**
  - There is \$7,186.67 in the booster club's account. Coach noted that there is additional \$3,830 to be deposited – collected from spirit fees.
  
- ❖ **Coach's Updates**
  - Team/Spirit Fees
    - For those who are making installment payments – next payment is due on 11/30
  - Picture Day
    - November 4<sup>th</sup> – players to wear uniforms
    - Rick Berns will take individual and team pictures. He will also take pictures during some of our games during the season
    - Picture order forms will be distributed to the players and will also be shared via email and on the website. Pictures will be available to view online
  - Rosters should be finalized by December 2nd
  - Uniforms
    - Nike still does not have inventory available for ordering
    - For now we will use the uniforms from last year
    - When the Nike uniforms become available – hopefully in January – varsity players will receive them
  - Schedules
    - Coach has created two calendars: one with scrimmage games and preseason tournaments, and the second one with season games
    - Players from JVA and Varsity will play in the Willis and Humble tournaments in January
    - Players from JVA and JVB will play in a tournament at Gosling fields in January
    - There will be another tournament in Deer Park for Varsity (including Varsity and some JVA players), and freshmen (including some JVA and JVB players). That way everyone will be included in playing, but also players will have time to rest
    - November 30<sup>th</sup> is the official start of the season
    - There will be double training sessions during holiday season in December (no training on 12/31)
  
  - Coach Ramos is helping out with training. The district is aware of it. The Booster Club will write a check to CISD, and then Coach Ramos will be compensated from these funds

- Freshmen players are not doing well at school – only 7 are currently eligible to play. It is important that parents make sure that the boys are passing their classes. Otherwise the season for freshmen will have to be cancelled.

#### ❖ **Committee Reports**

- Spirit Wear – Christy Steindorf
  - Nothing new to report at this time
- Concessions – Elsa Torres
  - We have an opportunity to work concessions at the Woodforest during two football games, November 27<sup>th</sup> and December 4<sup>th</sup>. 18 volunteers are needed per game (parents and players). We will make 9% profit of the sales, and will receive all tips. Sign up genius will be created for these events. Training for volunteers will be provided before the games – face shields will be mandatory
  - Concessions at Oak Ridge stadium – there will be two season games and three scrimmages at our stadium. Sign up genius will be created for volunteers to sign up. We need to decide whether we will donate items for the concession stand and perhaps ask the players for suggestions regarding drinks/snacks.
- Game Day Programs – Sarah Perusich
  - No updates – waiting for the rosters, pictures and suggestions for layout
- Season kick-off Cook-out
  - Date: December 10<sup>th</sup> – to be confirmed by coach – It will have to be outside and maybe on a different date when there is no game
  - Only prepackaged items are allowed – volunteers needed to get the packages ready - teams could donate the items

#### ❖ **New Business**

- Coach has asked for approval of an expense. Extra training tops were purchased for the new players that may be added after the 11/30 and 12/1 tryouts. The total amount requested - \$483. This expense was approved by the Booster Club
